

# LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

## Actions of the City Council for March 26, 2012

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### Legislation

(TO12-06) ORDINANCE SETTING THE RATE OF TAX LEVY ON REAL ESTATE, PERSONAL PROPERTY AND MACHINERY AND TOOLS, AND ALL OTHER PROPERTY SEGREGATED BY LAW FOR LOCAL TAXATION IN THE CITY OF FALLS CHURCH, VIRGINIA, FOR THE TAX YEAR 2012. (*Wyatt Shields, City Manager*)

**PASSED on first reading on roll call vote, unanimously 5-0, with ongoing public hearings on April 9 and 23<sup>rd</sup>; with second reading and final Council action scheduled for April 23<sup>rd</sup>. (Mr. Kaylin and Mr. Peppe were absent.)**

(TO12-07) AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND DETERMINING THE BUDGET OF EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2013: GENERAL FUND; SCHOOL OPERATING FUND; SCHOOL COMMUNITY SERVICE FUND; AND SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE FUND; WATER REVENUE FUND AND SEWER REVENUE FUND. (*Wyatt Shields, City Manager*)

**PASSED on first reading on roll call vote, unanimously 5-0, with ongoing public hearings on April 9 and 23<sup>rd</sup>; with second reading and final Council action scheduled for April 23<sup>rd</sup>. (Mr. Kaylin and Mr. Peppe were absent.)**

(TO12-08) AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND DETERMINING THE FY2013-FY2017 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING EXPENDITURE AND REVENUE FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2013. (*Wyatt Shields, City Manager*)

**PASSED on first reading on roll call vote, unanimously 5-0, with ongoing public hearings on April 9 and 23<sup>rd</sup>; with second reading and final Council action scheduled for April 23<sup>rd</sup>. (Mr. Kaylin and Mr. Peppe were absent.)**

(TO12-05) ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 42, "UTILITIES", TO REVISE SEWER RATES. (*Brenda Creel, Director of Public Utilities*)

**PASSED on first reading on roll call vote, unanimously 5-0; with second reading and public hearing scheduled for April 9, 2012. (Mr. Kaylin and Mr. Peppe were absent.)**

**(TR12-12)** RESOLUTION TO EVALUATE FUNDING ALTERNATIVES FOR STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

**PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 5-0. (Res. 2012-09) (Mr. Kaylin and Mr. Peppe were absent.)**
