## Actions of the City Council for May 26, 2015

### Resolutions and first readings of ordinances

**(TO15-08) ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES [1929 AND 1930], REGARDING THE BUDGET OF EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015 FOR THE GENERAL FUND AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FUNDS. Motion to grant first reading to (TR15-08), as amended, and schedule a public hearing and second reading on June 8, 2015, PASSED on roll call vote, 6-0 (Mr. Snyder was absent.)**

**(TR15-12) RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE EMPLOYEES' CONTRIBUTION TO THE VIRGINIA RETIREMENT SYSTEM EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015. Motion to adopt (TR15-12) PASSED on roll call vote, 6-0 (Mr. Snyder was absent.) (Res. 2015-13)**

### Consent Items

**(1) AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THREE (3) DUMP TRUCKS TO GOODPASTURE MOTOR COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$279,777, SUBJECT TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS BY CITY COUNCIL IN THE BUDGET**

**(2) PERMISSION FOR CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A PART TIME TEACHING POSITION WITH THE VIRGINIA TECH "CERTIFICATE IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANAGEMENT" PROGRAM**

**Motion to approve consent items PASSED on voice vote.**

### Closed Session

Closed Session pursuant to Va. Code Section 2.2-3711. (A) 3 for the "[d]iscussion or consideration...of the disposition of publicly held real property, where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body..., " in particular consideration of the sale of property at Park Place.
