

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Actions of the City Council for February 9, 2009

Legislation

(TO9-01) Ordinance to Amend Chapter 20, Motor Vehicles And Traffic, Of The Code Of The City Of Falls Church, Virginia, By Amending and Reenacting Section 20-18 “Use of Photo-Monitoring Systems to Enforce Traffic Light Signals; Penalty”

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Ord. 1828)

PUBLIC HEARING: (TR9-09) A Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Falls Church, Virginia Authorizing The Sale Of Its General Obligation Public Improvement Bonds In The Amount Of \$4,100,000.

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Res. 2009-08)

(TR9-10) Resolution Setting Forth The Purpose, Objectives, Membership, and Schedule of The Zoning Ordinance Advisory Committee (ZOAC).

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0, as amended. (Res. 2009-09)
