Actions of the City Council for July 27, 2009

Legislation

(1) **(TO9-10)** Ordinance To Amend The Budget Of Expenditures And Revenues of the General Fund and the Water Fund, and the Capital Improvement Plan to Appropriate Grant, Use of Fund Balance, and Other Revenues For The Fiscal Year 2010 (John Tuohy, CFO)

PASSED on roll call vote on first reading, unanimously 6-0, with public hearing and second reading scheduled for August 10, 2009. (Mr. Webb was absent.)

(2) **(TR9-23)** Resolution to Establish A Humanities Council: City of Arts, Theatre, Cultures and History (CATCH) (Cindy Mester, Assistant City Manager)

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 6-0, with City staff and the Planning Commission directed to develop options for the creation of a cultural district in the upcoming Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance updates. (Mr. Webb was absent.) (Res. 2009-23)
