Legislation

(TO9-10) Ordinance To Amend The Budget Of Expenditures And Revenues of the General Fund and the Water Fund, and the Capital Improvement Plan to Appropriate Grant, Use of Fund Balance, and Other Revenues For The Fiscal Year 2010 (John Tuohy, CFO)

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0 (Ord. 1833)
