

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Actions of the City Council for September 30, 2009

Legislation

(TO9-11) Ordinance To Authorize Removal And Repair Of Defacement, Including Graffiti
PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Ord. 1834)

(TO9-09) An Ordinance Adopting And Enacting A New Code For The City Of Falls Church, Virginia; Providing For The Repeal Of Certain Ordinances Not Included Therein; Providing A Penalty For The Violation Thereof; Providing For The Manner Of Amending Such Code; And Providing When Such Code And This Ordinance Shall Become Effective.

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Ord. 1835)

(TO9-12) Ordinance To Repeal And Reenact §20-62 Of Chapter 20 Of The Falls Church City Code, "Motor Vehicles And Traffic, Article VII, "Towing And Immobilization Of Vehicles," Section 20 – 62 "Removal Of Trespassing Vehicles By Owners Of Parking And Other Lot Or Building" In Accordance With The Code Of Virginia As Of July 1, 2009. (Harry Reitze, Chief of Police)

PASSED on first reading on roll call vote, 6-1, with Mr. Sze voting NAY; and staff was directed to continue to work with the interested parties on the proposed ordinance; with second reading and public hearing scheduled for Monday, October 26, 2009.
