

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Actions of the City Council for March 8, 2010

The following legislation was considered and acted upon by the City Council of the City of Falls Church. Copies of legislation are available from the City Clerk, Kathleen Buschow, 703-248-5014.

Legislation

(TO10-05) Ordinance To Revise Chapter 26 Of The Falls Church City Code, “Motor Vehicles And Traffic, Article V, “Towing And Immobilization Of Vehicles,” Section 26 – 136, “Towing Advisory Board” and Section 26-138, “Removal Of Trespassing Vehicles By Owners Of Parking And Other Lot Or Building” In Accordance With The Code Of Virginia As Of July 1, 2009.

PASSED on second reading on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Ord. 1841)

(TR10-14) Resolution Amending Resolution 2008-56 Authorizing The City Manager To Execute A “Commitment To Provide Long Term Financing” For The City Center South Apartment Project.

MOTION to forward TR10-14 to the Planning Commission, Economic Development Authority, the Housing Commission, Human Services Advisory Council and Senior Commission for recommendation and schedule for Council action on March 22, 2010.

PASSED on roll call vote, 6-1, with Mr. Baroukh voting NAY.

(TO10-06) Ordinance Amending Ordinance 1826 To Grant Real Estate Tax Exemption To City Center South Housing, LLC For City Center South Apartments For The Public Purpose Of Affordable Housing.

MOTION to approve (TO10-06) on first reading, refer to the Planning Commission, Economic Development Authority, Housing Commission, Human Services Advisory Council and Senior Commission, schedule a public hearing and second reading for March 22, 2010, and advertise the same according to law.

PASSED on roll call vote, 6-1, with Mr. Baroukh voting NAY.

Items Removed from Consent

(1) Authorize the City Manager to Award a Contract to American Disposal Services in an Amount Not to Exceed \$500,000 for Solid Waste Collection Services to Include the Provision of Carts for Residential Recycling & Refuse Use.

MOTION: MOVE to Authorize the City Manager to Award a Contract to American Disposal Services in an Amount Not to Exceed \$500,000 for Solid Waste Collection Services to Include the Provision of Carts for Residential Recycling & Refuse Use.

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0.
