Actions of the City Council for June 14, 2010

Legislation

(TO10-03-Rev) An Ordinance To Amend Chapter 48, Zoning, Of The Code Of The City Of Falls Church, Virginia, By Amending Sec. 48-1004, Table Of Use Types, In Order To Allow For Planning Commission Modifications To The Off-Street Parking And Loading Requirements At The Time Of Site Plan Approval. (Sue Cotellessa, GM Development Services)

MOTION to TABLE indefinitely; PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0.

(TO10-11) An Ordinance To Amend The Code Of The City Of Falls Church, Virginia, By Adding A New Article VI, Adult Uses, To Chapter 8, Businesses And Business Regulations And A New Division 10, Adult Uses, To Article V, Supplementary Regulations, Chapter 48 Zoning And By Amending Article I, Sec. 48-2 Definitions, And Article IV, District Regulations Regarding Adult Uses (Sue Cotellessa, GM Development Services)

MOTION to approve (TO10-11) on 1st Reading, refer to the Planning Commission, schedule 2nd Reading and public hearing for June 28, 2010, and advertise the same according to law; PASSED on roll call vote, 6-1, with Mr. Sze voting NAY.
