

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Actions of the City Council for June 28, 2010

Legislation

PUBLIC HEARING: (TR10-23) A Resolution to Raise the George Bus Fare Up To \$1.50 on July 1, 2010.

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Res. 2010-22)

(TO10-11) An Ordinance To Amend The Code Of The City Of Falls Church, Virginia, By Adding A New Article VI, Adult Uses, To Chapter 8, Businesses And Business Regulations And A New Division 10, Adult Uses, To Article V, Supplementary Regulations, Chapter 48 Zoning And By Amending Article I, Sec. 48-2 Definitions, And Article IV, District Regulations Regarding Adult Uses.

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Ord. 1846)

(TR10-24) Resolution to Authorize the City of Falls Church To Pick-Up A Portion Of The Employee's Contribution To VRS Under § 414 (H) Of The Internal Revenue Code For Employees Of Constitutional Offices Under VRS Plan 2.

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Res. 2010-23)

(TR10-25) Resolution Authorizing The City Manager To Sign The "Capital Funding Agreement."

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0, with an amended motion by Mr. Snyder to send letters to the Governor of Virginia and WMATA. (Res. 2010-24)
