

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Actions of the City Council for April 26, 2010

Revised

Legislation

(TO10-07) An Ordinance Setting the Rate of Tax Levy on Real Estate, Personal Property, Machinery and Tools and All Other Property Segregated by Law for Local Taxation in the City of Falls Church Virginia for the Tax Year 2010. [1st reading 3-22-10 and 4-12-10]

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Ord. 1843) [tax rate \$1.24]

(TO10-08) An Ordinance Fixing And Determining The Budget Of Expenditures And Revenues, Appropriating Funds For The Fiscal Year 2011: General Fund; School Operating Fund; School Community Service Fund; And School Food Service Fund; Water Revenue Fund And Sewer Revenue Fund [1st reading 3-22-10]

PASSED on roll call vote, unanimously 7-0. (Ord. 1844)

(TO10-03) Ordinance To Amend Chapter 48, Zoning, Of The Code Of The City Of Falls Church, Virginia, By Adding A New Section 48-455(3), Special Exceptions In The B-1, Limited Business District; Section 48-488(4), Special Exceptions In The B-2, Central Business District; And Section 48-523(3), Special Exceptions In The B-3, General Business District Uses; In Order To Allow By Special Exception, With Approval Criteria, Modifications To The Off-Street Parking And Loading Requirements. [1st public hearing 2-22-10]
