What's a Small Area Plan?

A small area plan (or SAP) defines a vision for redevelopment in a relatively small area of the City (usually 10 blocks or less). It helps shape the places we live, work, shop, and play in the City of Falls Church.

The City's SAP is divided into eight Planning Opportunity Areas (POA). The Community Meeting will discuss your vision for three of these POAs:

- Schools Related Parcels (POA 8)
- West End (POA 7)
- Gordon Road Triangle (POA 4)
