RE: WEST END CAMPUS UPGRADES

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The City of Falls Church, Falls Church City Public Schools and Falls Church Gateway Partners will soon begin construction on several infrastructure projects that are necessary to complete the construction of the new George Mason High School and the anticipated "Little City Commons" development that will be built at the site of the old high school.

There will be lane closures that may cause traffic delays over the next 6 months. You may wish to seek alternate routes.

Utility Undergrounding – Construction on Haycock Road December 2019 – February 2020, with single lane closure on Haycock Road.

West End Sanitary Sewer - Starting at the intersection of Route 7 and Haycock Road, the new sewer line will run under Shreve Road and Gordons Road in Fairfax County. Construction January – June 2020 with single lane closures on Shreve Road.

Mustang Alley Connector Sewer – Running between Route 7 along Haycock Road to Mustang Alley and along Mustang Alley to the new High School site. Construction February – June 2020 with single lane closure on Haycock Road.

All of the project work will be located within public right of way on City land. No impacts to residential private property are expected. We will keep area residents and businesses up to date about lane closures and do our best to keep traffic moving as smoothly as possible.
