# COMMUNITY FLOAT CHALLENGE

**WHO:** Floats can be made with neighbors down the street or in your apartment/condo complex, your family, or just a group of friends. **WHEN:** The 39th annual Memorial Day Parade is on Monday, May 25 at 2:00 p.m. Rain or shine. Line-up begins at 1:00 p.m.

**WHERE:** Parade route travels down Park Ave. between West St. and Little Falls St. Parade line-up spot will be sent along with confirmation details.

**WHY:** Because you love The Little City! And it's a great way to bond with friends and meet your neighbors! Plus, the most patriotic float wins a party hosted by the Recreation and Parks Department!

All floats must be appropriate for a family audience/community parade.

Stopping along the parade route is not permitted, including for performances. Participants are expected to follow the group in front of them. Your group performance in front of the review stand is limited to a maximum of 3 minutes. No throwing of objects of any kind including confetti from vehicles or by any walker. Equipment and/or decorations may not obstruct the driver's view.
