

GRANT PROGRAMS

Housing and Human Services administers Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) Program funding. HHS also administers the locally funded Community Services Funds and City's Affordable Housing Fund.

CDBG/HOME:

- ◆ Funding is awarded to housing and community based services organizations that provide services to low and moderate income and/or disabled persons living in the City
- ◆ Applications accepted in September

COMMUNITY SERVICES FUNDS:

- ◆ Funding is awarded to non-profit organizations serving City residents
- ◆ Applications accepted in December

AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND:

- ◆ Funding is awarded to non-profit and for profit organizations and to City of Falls Church general government
- ◆ Projects must promote preservation and/or development of affordable housing
- ◆ Funding maybe for bridge loans, financing, or predevelopment grants
- ◆ Applications accepted year-round


