AUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$287,000 UNDER AN EXISTING CONTRACT WITH KLOKE GROUP AKA KLOKE TRANSFER FOR THE MARY RILEY STYLES LIBRARY RENOVATION AND EXPANSION PROJECT

MOTION to authorize the expenditure of up to \$287,000 under an existing contract with Kloke Group aka Kloke Transfer for the Mary Riley Styles Library Renovation and Expansion Project and such contract shall include a termination for convenience clause which shall expose the city to no greater than \$5,000 liability PASSED 4-2. (NAYS – Ms. Hardi, Mr. Litkenhous.)
