Attempted Carjacking, Stolen Motor Vehicle, Wilson Blvd, November 14, 5:06 PM, a female sitting in her car was attacked by a suspect described as a 5'8", thinly built, black male, short hair, wearing light clothing. After attempting unsuccessfully to remove her from her vehicle, he entered a nearby unoccupied 2014 Jeep Cherokee with its motor still running. Suspect last seen driving away in the Jeep. Vehicle recovered November 16 in Washington, DC. Investigation continues.
