

Spring Crafts

Egg Carton Chicks * Be sure to check with your parents before starting.

Need: Egg carton, tape, black marker, paint, paint brush, scissors, glue, paper

Steps: (see attached picture)

1. Cut apart two egg holders from the carton and trim off the excess on the edges.
2. Glue two pieces together (one on top of the other). If you would like the chick to open and close, it's a good idea to tape the back half instead of glue.
3. Paint and allow to dry.
4. Fold a piece of paper in half and cut out a triangle to make the beak. Glue it on.
5. Draw two eyes using a black marker.
6. Cut out two wings, two feet and a feather for the top.
7. Glue them on to the egg carton.



Toilet Paper Roll Bunny * Be sure to check with your parents before starting.

Need: Toilet paper roll, paint brush, paint, glue (hot glue gun works best), scissors

Steps: (see attached picture)

1. Paint the toilet paper roll.
2. Cut it into 5 circle pieces. Paint the inside of the rolls (optional).
3. Place a dab of hot glue in the middle of one of the circle pieces and press it together to form the bunny's feet.
4. Place a dab of glue on the top of the feet piece and press another circle piece on top to make the belly.
5. Repeat step 4 for the head.
6. Take the last two circles, fold each one, pinch tightly and let it go to form an ear.
7. Glue them on to the head.



If you don't have a hot glue gun....

Need: Toilet paper roll, paint brush, paint, scissors, paper

Steps: (see attached picture)

1. Pour paint onto a paper plate.
2. Cut the toilet paper roll into 5 circle pieces.
3. Take one circle and squeeze together, pinching in the middle.
4. Place it in the paint while squeezing together and then stamp it onto the paper (the feet).
5. Take another circle piece, place it in the paint and stamp it onto the paper above the feet to make the stomach.
6. Repeat step 5 to make the head.
6. Take another circle, fold it together, pinch tightly and let it go to form an ear.
7. Place it in the paint and then stamp it on top of the head for ears.
8. You now have the outline of your bunny. You can leave it as is, fill in the shapes or create a whole picture and decorate the surroundings.
