### Frequently Asked Questions



#### What are the Community Center hours?

The Community Center will be utilized from 8:30-4pm weekdays for our REC CONNECT E-Learning Program and Monday through Thursday evenings and Saturdays for scheduled classes and youth basketball during the season.

The Community Center is currently open for the sole use of scheduled programming. There is no drop-in use or visits permitted at this time. If you need assistance, please call our front desk at 703-248-5027 (TTY 711) or email

#### Will there be a health check/screening prior to entry?

All persons participating in our REC CONNECT program or scheduled classes/programs will be required to participate in a daily health screening prior to entry. Participants will not be permitted in the building if they:

- Have a temperature of 100.4 or higher or have, within the last 12 hours, taken any medication that would lower their temperature.
- Have a cough or shortness of breath.
- If anyone in their household is known to have COVID-19 at any time within the past 14 days.
- If they are aware of having close, personal contact with a COVID-19 positive individual in the past 14 days.

Staff have contactless thermometers which can be used if a participant did not take their temperature prior to arrival. Staff will also observe all participants for watery eyes, coughing, sneezing, etc.

**A parent/guardian must arrive to the building with children attending class so they can sign the health check documentation.**

#### Will I or my child be required to wear a mask?

Yes. The department is adhering to Governor's orders which mandates the use of masks in public spaces. We require masks to be worn by all participants ages 3 and up.

#### Will I be able to stay in the building while my child is in class?

Unfortunately the answer is no. Parent/Guardians may escort children aged 10 and younger to their class location and must then exit the building until it is time for pickup. Parents must remain at the Community Center campus while young children are in class, just not inside the building. All seating areas have been removed and lingering in the building is prohibited at this time.

#### What changes can I expect when I come to the Community Center?

- A table will be set up at the entrance with a Plexiglas barrier. This is where the health check will take place.
- A barrier is in place at the front desk.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers are available at the front entrance and on each level of the building.
- We have increased cleaning and disinfecting throughout the facility.
- We have staggered class start times and breaks in between classes to decrease interactions.
- Additional COVID-19 signage is in place throughout the building.
- Shared equipment such as yoga mats, etc. are not available.
- Floor stickers or rubber dots are spaced out for social distancing.

#### Is the Community Center available for drop-in use?

The building is not yet open for drop-in use. Reserved gym use is available to City residents who have registered for available time slots. Visit [www.fallschurchva.gov/OpenGym](http://www.fallschurchva.gov/OpenGym) for information on reserving a timeslot.

#### Is there anything else I should know before classes begin?

- Arrive dressed for class.
- Limit any personal items you bring with you to class.
- Restrooms are open but showers are closed.
