### Spring 2022 Schedule of Events:

Date	Location	Time
March 19	Cavalier Trail Park - invasive removal	10am - noon
April 9	Howard Herman Stream Valley Park – invasive removal	10am - noon
May 14	Cherry Hill Park – invasive removal	10am - noon

### Event Locations:

Cavalier Trail Park – (Entrance is adjacent to Aurora House at 420 S. Maple Avenue 22046) From the intersection of rt. 7 and rt. 29, head south on rt. 29. Turn right onto Maple Avenue then make an almost immediate left into the Cavalier Trail Park parking lot. Look for wayfinding signs.

Cherry Hill Park – (Park is adjacent to Community Center at 223 Little Falls Street 22046) From West Street head east on Broad Street (Rt. 7). Turn left onto Little Falls Street. Turn left into the Community Center entrance – parking is in the rear. Look for wayfinding signs.

Howard Herman Park – (Enter the park adjacent to 425 Rollins Street 22046) From West St. head east on Broad St. (Rt. 7). Turn right onto South Virginia Avenue then right again to stay on South Virginia Avenue. Then a right onto Rollins, the street dead-ends at the park. Follow the gravel path across the stream to our work location. You can also enter behind Oak Street Elementary School following the trail across the bridge or using the trail entrance near the Byron (Penzey’s Spice Building) off of West Broad Street. Look for wayfinding signs.
